Although his first experiences with IT dates back to the 1960's Robert only became involved with open source in 1996 after ordering a CD distribution of Linux online.

His current open source activities includes writing to publications such as [Sys-Admin](#), the O'Reilly webportal [ONLamp.com](#) and casestudies for the PostgreSQL community. He is also the maintainer of [pg_live](#), a live CD distro filled with documentation and reference to profile PostgreSQL for first time users.
