Managing Photo Collections: Glitches and Frustrations

Some of the software mentioned will be - DigiKam - Geeqie - Gwenview - gThumb - Irfanview (yes, we know it's originally a Windoze program) - Mapivi - exiftool, exiv2, rdjpgcom, wrjpgcom - several of the author's own scripts and programs such as jpgdir2htm, JNjpgCom, and others

Similar to last time, your output video and audio will be disabled when you join. In order to make sure the experience is a reasonable one for all involved, the presenter will share their screen-window-whatever they are comfortable with and you will see it quite clearly. Rather than unmute, pressing your space bar is supposed to unmute your microphone while pressed, so you can try that to ask questions. There is also

the chat window, but when it is active it obscures part of the screen. Feel free to post questions and as opportunity presents itself and the presenter notices, they will get answered. After the presentation is completed, feel free to unmute and have a normal voice/video Q&A.
