svn database in Berkeley style database file

- repository in /home/svn on old and new machines

dump

- on old tux, dump DB contents

```
svnadmin dump /home/svn > svn.dump.file
```

load

- copy dump file to new machine
- on new tux, remove contents of /home/svn
- on new tux, create new repository with

```
svnadmin create /home/svn
```

- load database contents into fresh clean repository

```
svnadmin load /home/svn < svn.dump.file
```

check

- find last revision number on old tux and new tux

```
svnlook youngest /home/svn
```

- verify these commands output identical info on old and new tux

```
svn -v status file:///home/svn  
svn info /home/svn
```
